- Council of Community Services Gillette (Founded in 1968 the Council of Community Services provides a diverse, supportive network of services to people seeking to improve their lives. Their programs focus on solutions to homelessness, hunger, and emergency assistance.)
- YES House Gillette (A private, non-profit agency, services are provided to young people, ages 5-24, and their families in the state of Wyoming. The goal is to keep families together whenever possible and appropriate.)
- Salvation Army Gillette (An international movement, is an evangelical part of the universal Christian Church. Its message is based on the Bible. Its ministry is motivated by the love of God. Its mission is to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and to meet human needs in His name without discrimination.)
- Mexico Missions & Beyond Cuba Pathfinders (Mission: "To change lives through short term
 missions. We are an organization that provides a wholesome atmosphere, in which families,
 young people and older alike, can come and serve the Lord without compromising principle or
 conscience.") Also looking for uniforms you care to donate.

Acceptable donations
